

## The Restorative Academy Series

### PURPOSE:

This program is intended for dentists that have a special interest in incorporating more advanced restorative procedures into their practice. The course is designed to present a multi-disciplinary approach to dentistry with the purpose of helping build the ideal “restorative team”.

Special emphasis will be given to the areas of dental photography, occlusal evaluation and diagnostic wax-ups, with the purpose of improving communication and treatment plan design among participants. Smile analysis, esthetic mock-ups and bonded functional esthetic prototypes will be included, and the importance of their use demonstrated.


Participants are encouraged to start and finish a clinical case in their own practice, and present the case following all the guidelines obtained throughout the course.

**Mario F. Romero** is the Director of Romero Dental Seminars. He received his DDS degree from the University of Guayaquil (Ecuador) School of Dentistry in 1995. He then completed a two-year Advanced Education in General Dentistry Program at the University of Rochester, Eastman Institute for Oral Health where he was granted the Handleman Award for Excellence.
